- 4. Mapping should be made in the syllabus.
- 5. Consultancy by faculty and students needs to be strengthened.
- 6. Creativity among the students have to be promoted.
- 7. Placement of the students in the departments are good.
- 8. Faculty Student Ratio is good.
- Faculty may be encouraged to apply minor projects through various funding agencies.
- 10. Publications should be made in Scopus Indexed Journal. Teachers should be motivated by providing incentives.
- 11. Alumni Association may be registered.
- 12. Faculty members may be motivated to create SWAYAM and MOOC Courses.


