ABSTRACT

Eugene O'Neil is one of the greatest American dramatists. He is a prominent dramatist of modern age. His writing style is purely an objective kind of drama showing the working of the man's mind and conscience. His dramas are preoccupied with spiritual values, inner conflicts, anguish, failure, and pride. His great play *The Emperor Jones* about a Negro, who by chance landed in West Indies and made himself an Emperor. The protagonist named Jones, though luck has played a part, but he has been quick to take advantage of it. He could make them believe that he had been protected by a charm, so silver bullet could harm him. As the people were snappy with his rule, they have ministered up courage and came to the fighting point by calling local gods and demons of the forest. Jones realized his reign is over, he makes preparation for his escape to the coast where a French gunboat is anchored. During the night, many formless fears creep on him, those are not only from his own life but old race fears. He used up six bullets out of his own mental trauma just by hearing the drum sound produced by the revolutionaries. The author expressed the whole mental trauma through expressive words and actions throughout the play. Finally, he reached to the point of being defenceless and exhausted. He had made a complete circle in the jungle as his panic whipped him on.

Eugene O'Neil could be considered as father of modern American drama. He has written more than sixty plays and regarded as the American Shakespeare. Eugene O'Neil is the foremost American dramatist of psychology. He shows man battling with harsh environments and with his own inner passions. His interest in the human psyche was so great that it made him follow the discoveries in psychoanalysis and make it use them into his

plays. His play, *The Emperor Jones*, is credited as being one that provided "Several firsts in American theatre history: the Provincetown Players' first major hit, the first major role for an African American actor on the legitimate Broadway stage (in houses where the audience was still racially segregated), and the play that secured O'Neil's place as a writer for the high-art, experimental theatre worthy of international attention" (Stein 343). His interest in the intricate workings of the human soul has given an extra dimension to his tragedies. He constantly taps the inner stream of consciousness of the subconscious, of his characters.

The whole is play around Brutus Jones as he undergoes various fears, visions and dreams. Smithers, his companion instils the idea of spell and enchantment of the revolutionaries. Tom-tom sound of the drum played vital role throughout the play. When Jones made an attempt to save himself from the native people, he escaped into the forest. The forest is the place which was very familiar to him. He knew all the look and contour of the forest. But as the night falls, the darkness brought fear in him. Whenever his fear risen, he could hear the tom-tom sound at high. He began to see visions there. Even small movements around that made him frightened. He used his gun to chase the suspicious animal. Then he felt assured that he was safe.

Brutus Jones began to experience various "formless fears". Then he saw a ghost of Jeff, whom he had killed. But all are illusions which pop up in his mind as he was disturbed. He remembered clearly what Smithers had informed him. The native people doing some ritual to invoke the spiritual things in the forest to get revenge of Jones. As Jones belonged to their tribe, those kind of beliefs were implanted in his roots, that he couldn't shake it off. Then through moonlight he could see a gang of black convicts and a white supervisor. He has seen them work with shovel in their hands. The supervisor ill-treat Jones and out of rage he makes use of the gun to shot him. Immediately after that,

ABSTRACT

Clustering has a significant role in data mining. Many techniques are used by the researchers for clustering the large sized data objects. Though, the efficient clustering model is required to cluster the heavily inhabited large sized data objects with better clustering accurateness and should reduce the clustering period. Metric Space Clustering (MSC) method is proposed to overcome the limitations in clustering. In the space dimensionality MSC method work on the heavily inhabited large sized data objects and easily recognize the symmetric objects and form a cluster with high accuracy level. Initially, The proposed MSC method efficiently clustering the heavily inhabited large sized data objects using the proposed Metric Space Dimensional Clustering algorithm (MSDC).

1. INTRODUCTION

Data mining refers to extort the knowledge from large amount of database. Help of the development of technology, it is much easier to collect the data in dissimilar fields. Although, it produced huge and complicated datasets. Clustering has been broadly exploited in a variety of areas, ranging from science to engineering. The objective of clustering is to assign the analogous data patterns into the similar cluster and to expose the consequential structure of the data.

In current times, a lot of research works has been designed for clustering the heavily inhabited large sized data objects. For instance, clustering heavily inhabited large sized data objects that integrates subspace knowledge and clustering via a common procedure, which was applied in the period for clustering process. Predictive Subspace Clustering (PSC) was developed to cluster the heavily inhabited large sized data objects in [2]. Though, Predictive Subspace Clustering is not considered for heavily inhabited large sized data objects.

In Based Manufacturing Process (BPM) approach in [3], carried out the similarity measurement for such manufacturing process models and it performs the hierarchical clustering based on the Representation Coefficient Vectors (RCV) in [4] for clustering heavily inhabited large sized data objects to not increase the accurateness of clustering but decreasing the period for clustering.

In [5], to cluster the heavily inhabited large sized data objects in projected space, a novel optimization intelligence. But, this technique occupies more memory space for storing the large sized data objects. But, the accurateness of clustering is not at required level. Furthermore, in [6], a Robust Multi Objective Subspace Clustering (RMOSC) algorithm was developed, which outcome was to improve the accurateness of the subspace clustering. In [7], an Incremental Semi Supervised Clustering Ensemble approach (ISSE) was explained, in that the constraint propagation approach to carry out the clustering of large sized data objects which uses the gain of random subspace method. Diminish the computational complexity and to enlarge the accuracy of large sized data objects clustering. A Novel H-K clustering algorithm was implemented in [8] but the space complexity

AN ENHANCED APPROACH FOR NIGHT TIME RAINY IMAGE ENHANCEMENT USING DEMNET BASED ON CONVOLUTIONAL NEURAL NETWORKS

ABSTRACT

The external computer vision system has fails to update the low vision rainy images in clear effect especially at night time rainy images. The night time rainy images are contains light scattering and absorption problems with poor illumination conditions so visualization systems take this enhancement process as a strangulation process. In this paper, proposed the method DEMNet is based on the deep learning for low illumination rainy image and enhance the poor quality images were captured on rainy season at night time. This method is applied only for night time single rainy images. First of all, DeNet is used to separate reflection image and illumination image from the input image. Next, the E-Net is used for adjustment of poor illumination and which is deployed for adjust the illumination effect from the rainy image. Next, M-Net method is used for extract the night time rainy features from direct rain image and for this purpose contextual auto-encoder is employed. Finally, apply adaptive sturdy guided filter to remove the noise from the image. At last, the rainy streaks and poor illuminations are removed and update enhanced night time rainy image. Hence, the proposed method provides the good results in terms of PSNR and SSIM than state-of-art methods.

1. INTRODUCTION

The night time captured rainy images look like very blurred and dark because of dim brightness with low illumination so the external computer vision system has fails to update the low vision in night time rainy images. The captured image also affected by camera reflections or other lights reflections. The proposed method highly satisfies the computer vision applications [1] to [2].

The existing methods had unsuccessful to update the night time rainy images [3-9]. In the existing method, focused on the removing rainy streaks from rainy video and also focused the single image deraining. Non-local mean smoothing technique is used to remove the rainy streaks from single rainy images and consider the rain removal process as a signal divided problem [5-9]. Nowadays, deep learning based methods are improved step by step with more recent techniques. Therefore, the deep learning based methods are successively provides results on daytime single rainy image enhancement [1-11].

The night time rainy images are very complex to enhance than day time rainy images in existing algorithms. The night time rainy images are much degraded with poor illumination than day time of light reflections and poor illuminations [13-18].

The proposed method is addressed low brightness, low contrast, and low illumination problems of nighttime rainy images. The DeepNet method is based on the combine deep neural network of joined sub nets. Here, the proposed method concentrates only on the poor illumination and light reflectance of blurred than daytime rainy images so we want to evaluate illumination, reflectance, noise and rainy streaks removal by combination of three subsets [12].

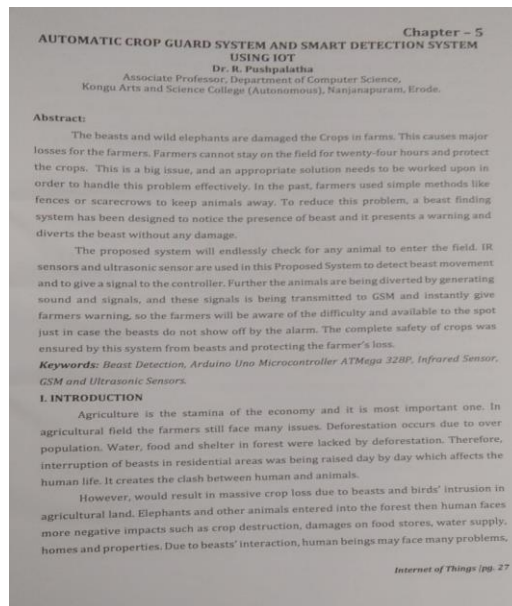
