Pre-incubation is the process that usually involves a technology-focused business idea or project, where start-ups that have started working alone or with a team but have not been incorporated to make this idea come true. Entrepreneurs in the pre-incubation process need specific training, mentoring and consultancy services to understand whether their ideas are viable, commercializable, scalable, etc.


Pre-incubation centres provide these opportunities to early-stage entrepreneurs for an average of six months to a year. In addition to these, the physical facilities needed by entrepreneurs such as open offices and common working areas are provided to entrepreneurs by pre-incubation centres.

At the end of the pre-incubation period, entrepreneurs who complete the business plan and are ready for incorporation, start the incubation phase. During the incubation period, entrepreneurs continue to need physical facilities and training, consultancy and mentoring services, similar to the pre-incubation phases.

The facilities of pre incubation centre are:

- Giving awareness
- Conducting completions
- Organizing programs for the entrepreneurs
- Discussion and mentoring

After evaluating the ideas from students the prospective ideas are diverted to incubation centre of our parent Institution in Kongu TBI. The students will get the mentoring support, funding support and further assistance to go for stat ups.




