ANNUAL REPORT 2025-2026

Kongu Arts and Science College, established in 1994 by Kongu Vellalar Institute of Technology Trust, is an autonomous, co-educational institution affiliated to Bharathiar University, Coimbatore. Founded with the noble mission of empowering rural youth through quality higher education, the college has grown into a centre of academic excellence. Spread across a serene 27.24-acre green campus, it offers an ideal environment for learning and holistic development.

The institution is accredited with NAAC A+ Grade (3.49/4 in Cycle IV), certified under ISO 21001:2018, and recognized as a NIRF-ranked college. Granted autonomy in 2015, the college is among the few institutions in the region offering AICTE-approved BBA and BCA programmes.

Currently, the college offers 21 undergraduate, 9 postgraduate, and Ph.D. programmes in 10 disciplines, along with 43 value-added courses and 2 professional coaching programmes to enhance employability. With a student strength of 3,714 (2,030 boys and 1,684 girls), supported by 208 teaching and 67 non-teaching staff members.

INAUGURATION OF FIRST YEAR CLASSES

The first-year UG classes for the academic year were inaugurated on 27.06.2025. 'Kavimamani' Marabin Maindhan Muthaiya, Writer and Speaker, delivered the inaugural address, and Swami Yogamruthanandar of Ramakrishna Mission Vidyalaya, Coimbatore, offered his blessings. The first-year PG classes were inaugurated on 16.07.2025.

ACCOLADES OF THE INSTITUTION

Some significant achievements during the academic year 2025–2026 include:

- Kongu Arts and Science College has recently received the State Level First Prize in the Best Anti-Drug Club Award 2024–2025, along with a Trophy, Certificates, and a Cash Prize of Rs.1,00,000, presented by the Hon'ble Deputy Chief Minister of Tamil Nadu.

- The college was honoured with the Tamil Nadu Green Champion Award 2024, accompanied by a cash prize of ₹1,00,000. The institution was recognized among 100 institutions and individuals for its outstanding contributions to environmental conservation and protection.
- The Institution received the MongoDB Skilling Excellence Award 2025 on 10th February 2026. The award was presented by ICT Academy in association with MongoDB for the college's efforts in student skill development and industry-focused training.
- In 2025, National Institutional Ranking Framework (NIRF) Ranking 2025 was released by the Ministry of Education, Government of India, the college secured a position in the 201–300 rank band among 4,030 participating institutions across the country.
- In India Today Rankings 2025, the college secured positions among the Top 100 in seven categories: Costume Design and Fashion (39th), Hotel Management (63rd), BCA (71st), BBA (74th), Science (79th), Commerce (87th), and Arts (86th). At the Erode district level, the college holds the first position in all these categories.
- At All-India level, the institution recorded the highest gain in the Top Gainers category, securing 1st place in Arts and 3rd place in Costume Design and Fashion. In the Best Value for Money category, the college ranked 2nd in Hotel Management and 10th in Costume Design and Fashion.
- In Outlook ICARE Rankings 2025, the college once again secured a place among the Top 100 in multiple categories: Commerce (76th), BCA (65th), BBA (87th), and Arts (95th). At the Erode district level, the college was ranked first in each of these categories.
- Kongu Arts and Science College was certified under ISO 21001:2018 (Educational Organizations Management System) from October 2025, becoming the first college in Erode to receive this recognition. This milestone reflects the

institution's strong commitment to global educational standards, student success, effective quality management practices, and continuous improvement.

- Department of Biochemistry received a Special Award from the District Collector, Erode, for organizing voluntary blood donation camps during 2024–2025. The award was presented on National Voluntary Blood Donation Day – 2025.
